What is Confidence Learning Center?

Located in the Brainerd Lakes Area of Minnesota, Confidence Learning Center otherwise known as Camp Confidence, is a premiere nationally renowned outdoor center for persons with developmental disabilities. Camp Confidence began in April of 1969 when Dick Endres (Camp Founder), a small group of business people, and many individuals from the Brainerd State Hospital combined their energies to form what is now known as Confidence Learning Center. From that day forward, Camp has had incredible growth both in the number of campers and facilities.

Confidence Learning Center is a 501(c)3 charity in its purest form. Camp Confidence receives no federal, state or local tax dollars, what we do have is a collage of individuals, families, corporations, service clubs, and small businesses that have helped us develop 140 acres into a year round camp for persons of all ages with developmental disabilities. Nearly 100% of our facilities and program equipment have been paid for or built through cash or in-kind donations.

The esthetic setting of Camp provides an appealing environment for continual training in self help skills, such as independent living skills, social adaptability, work habits, and life long leisure skills. It's truly a camp unique from most others. The programs at Camp Confidence are aimed at promoting self-confidence and self-esteem. The campers achieve this through active hands-on activities and participation in a variety of outdoor experiences. Camp staff are able to provide activities in outdoor education and recreation that are not or can not be offered in their local setting.

Campers are brought to Camp from all over Minnesota and the Midwest by their staff, family, guardian, teacher or caregiver, who is responsible for the needs and care of the group members. The typical overnight group stay is two nights/three days, however, longer or shorter stays are available. Visiting groups include group homes, families, public schools, state facilities, treatment centers, achievement centers, and scout-groups. Visiting groups are responsible for their own food, personal gear, transportation, and adequate staffing. Camp provides facilities and equipment, as well as a number of program specialists and college interns to assist the groups with activities and programs. Groups can participate in outdoor activities as well as indoor through our Nature Center, arts & crafts, the astronomy room in the John Mariucci Lodge. Camp staff are able to adapt many activities to accommodate different ability levels. The opportunity to interact and network with others is encouraged, however, each group's experience is tailored to meet individual needs and desires.

Over the years, thousands of individuals with disabilities have experienced personal growth while participating in educational programs which include archery, cross country skiing, canoeing, and fishing just to mention a few. Each activity at Confidence Learning Center allows campers to challenge their limits and prove themselves to the most important person of all, themselves.

- To facilitate exceptional learning experience for families, direct care staff, interns, and professionals in the field of developmental disabilities

Strengths include:

Program & Facility Strengths:

- Maintaining more than 10,000 camper days for the past 10 years
- Four full-time program staff with more than 55 years experience
- Volunteer staff hours totaling 8,000 hours or more each year
- Facilities (28 bed cabin, new duplex, gazebo and updated animal sanctuary)
- New boats and motors that are wheelchair accessible each year
- Indoor program areas in the Mariucci Lodge
- Partnerships Camp Sertoma, Camp Journey, Minnesota Organization on Fetal Alcohol Syndrome (MOFAS), Fishing Has No Boundaries, Area 5 Special Olympics and Brained Community Education programs

Program Weaknesses:

- Hilly terrain
- Annual funding dependent
- Increased expenses including utilities, maintenance, staff and insurance
- We have been adapting and modifying, not replacing with current updated equipment

Administration, Marketing and Fundraising Strengths:

- Camper market is growing. There is an increased need for our program, our campers are living longer
- Dedicated Board of Directors
- Positive reputation locally, statewide and nationally including United Way, Jaycees, Eagles, Lions, Rotary, Kiwanis, Sertoma etc.
- 501(c)3 status, Charities Review Council Meets Standards Seal
- We have been diversifying our funding strategic to include better use of the internet, partnering grants, direct mail, in-kind and cash donations, online giving
- We have improved our office technology

Vision:

On a three to five year timeline, recognizing the economy may continue to be unstable and the campership demand may increase, Confidence Learning Center will attempt to diversify its funding sources statewide, with a better marketing of our program locally and statewide, for our persons with developmental disabilities. At this time we do not plan or for see any campaign to raise dollars for new buildings.

Business Objective:

- Annually finance and provide consistent year-round safe and quality programs

Major Goals:

- Have a safe and quality program and facility
- Provide an economical opportunity as possible for our "campers"
- Have one years operating budget deposited in the bank

Specific Strategic Action:

- Immediately employ and build a statewide promotional team and develop a specific strategies with service clubs: Jaycees, Lions, Eagles, and Knights of Columbus
- Develop an annually increased endowment fund
- Develop new programs focusing on developmental disability awareness and deaf/hearing impaired

Key Strategies:

- Maintain and increase current local partnerships with existing funding sources including the United Way, the Brained Jaycee's Extravaganza, Eagles, Lions, and Sertoma
 - Expand and diversify current Board of Directors
 - Target marketing and fundraising outside the Brained Lakes Area. Identify and target areas where campers currently come from and where we can find potential campers
